PROGRAMME OF COOPERATION IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION IN 1994 - 1995, BETWEEN THE CITY OF CRACOW IN POLAND AND THE CITY OF GÖTEBORG IN SWEDEN

The following programme of environmental cooperation between the cities of Cracow and Göteborg in 1994 - 1995 has been agreed on as a result of discussions taking place in Göteborg 7 March 1994.

- Evaluation of suitable technological possibilities and assessment of offered municipal waste utilization systems.
 Göteborgs assistance in finding a proper method of composting, taking into consideration the composition of the waste and the level of modernization in environmental protection.
- 2. Göteborgs assistance in preparing a program that will stimulate the ecological awareness among children, youth and adults, and leading to the establishing of an economic incentive system for ecological investments in households in order to eliminate coal furnaces.
- 3. Visit of planners from Göteborg in Cracow and their participation in seminars on the actualization of the Physical Masterplan.
- 4. Visit of municipality representatives from Cracow in Göteborg in order to obtain information on how to identify and minimize city development barriers (ecological, economic, physical).
- 5. Göteborgs assistance in planning for public transportation (steering and control systems) and in providing second-hand buses.
- 6. Exchange of opinions on actual solutions being prepared in the framework of Cracow's General Plan of Physical Planning concerning the city transportation system.
- 7. Exchange of experience from the state of the art methods and technologies of exhaust gas purification, water and sewage treatment, municipal waste neutralization and noise protection
